Pastor August H Falkenberg served the Winedale
Haw Creek Round Top Churches.

He retired and moved to Burton where he lived
until his death on August 25 1949.

according to the Martin Luther Lutheran
Church books which states that:

Rev. August H Falkenberg was born on
December 10 1886 in Yorktown, Texas.

He attended the Lutheran College in Brenham,
Texas, Wartburg Theological Seminary in
Dubuque Iowa, and also did one year of
graduate work in Chicago.

He was ordained June 13 1909 in St. Peter's
Lutheran Church in Gay Hill Texas. by his
Father Pastor Aug Falkenberg Sr

He then served Gay Hill until 1914.

He served various other churches as well as Camine,
Round Top, Winedale and Haw Creek. Churches.

He was married to Lillian Baresche Oct 27 1909.

Pastor Brunotte left Carmine and Winedale Church to serve the Philipsburg Congregation and Pastor Simons took over the Carmine and Winedale Churches in 1944.

Simons served the Winedale Church for 2 years from 1944 through 1946.

Pastor Simons discontinued Winedale Church claiming inconvenience and gas expenses whereby the the Winedale Church was forced to decline their services, without a release, or transfer. leaving them stranded without a pastor

When Gottfried and his wife Caroline Braun sold all of their land to retire, they reserved 1 acre of their land on which a Evangelical Lutheran Church should be build, they would then donate this acre to this Church.

This Church building was build in 1868 by the Church Congregation and was dedicated by Pastor J. Krawl Jan 1 1869 as a Evangelical Trinity Lutheran Church and was given a deed Recorded Noo 19 1887 in La Grange Court house.

With Church being performed in this building for 25 years they decided to add the School to this Church which started in 1896.

They then needed a playground for the children and bought this 1st tract of land, from Wm Menno and Peter Jaeger June 2 1894 and was recorded June 29 1894 with Armin Witte, Rudolph Witte and Henry Burgmann as school trustees

15 years later the 2nd tract of land was bought from Wm Wickel and his wife Wilhelmina, containing an area of $1\frac{1}{100}$ acre with George Mayu Henry Steffer and Henry Wickel as school trustees

This tract was bought Dec 28 1909 and was

Recorded Jan 18 1910.

30 years later the 3rd tract of land was bought from Herman and Anna Muske and Wilhelmine Wickel with R. H. Mayer H. C. A. Ulbrich and W. A. Williams as trustees. This tract contains $\frac{3}{4}$ acre of land. This tract was bought June 14 1930.

In 1943 the Winedale School Consolidated with the Burton School Dist. These three tracts of Winedale School ground were sold to Alfred and Lina Wagner by 7 Burton School trustees and was recorded Dec 12 1945.

After reading the field notes it states: There is expressly Excepted from this conveyance. The School House and outhouses used in connection with such School House, together with all fixtures and equipment attached to and pertaining to the School house now situated on said property.

After this School property (3 tracts of land) was sold to Alfred Wagner the Church was still continued in this Church building ^{through} until 1946 when Pastor Leon Simon refused to continue to serve the congregation and quit. leaving the

entire Congregation abandoned and stranded, without a release, without a transfer to another Church the Congregation were forced to close the doors of their own Church and find other Churches to continue their worship leaving their membership in reman in the Evangelical Lutheran Trinity Church whereby it should be left untouched and remain as left by the Congregation.

In May 26, 1956 these 3 tracts of land were sold by Alfred and Lina Wagner to Louis A Muske and his wife Viola Muske exactly the same way he bought them from Burton School Dist.

Omitting the Winedale Church building Remaining the Evangelical Lutheran Trinity Church

However this building has been completely gutted with all the interior walls, ceiling, windows, destroyed and conveyed to a barn without any Church members knowledge or permission, than had this building appraised by Brennan Tax appraiser where by he could classify this Church building as a barn and claims this building ownership by the statue of taxation limitation

Louis Muske attended the Church in this building with his parents as a small boy, Later he was School trustee of the Burton School District, and was well aware of this being a Church. He was one of the seven school trustees of the Burton Independent School District, when the Winedale School property was sold to Alfred Wagner and fully understood that the Church building with all furniture inside was not included in this land sale and was expressly excepted and reserved from this conveyance as stated in the deed. This is destruction and vandalism.

To destroy this Church building was an Vandalic act. The 7 Burton School District who sold the Winedale School land were:

Not any of these School trustees were members of the Winedale Lutheran Church except Louis Muske
